BACKGROUND:

The Dancer in Me Sacred Arts & Music Training Institute began in 2011 in Los Angeles, CA with roughly 150 participants, expanding to nearly 700 registered attendees, and is now in its 10th year of production under the leadership of the non-profit 501c3 organization founded by husband & wife team Steve & Rev. Stephanie Adams, Long Beach Unity Inc.

Having been sent to the 16th District as an ordained deacon originally under the leadership of Bishop John & Rev. Cecelia Bryant (10th District, Texas) Rev. Adams served in Jamaica for 11.5 years under the leadership of AME Bishops William DeVeaux, Carolyn Tyler-Guidry, and Sara Frances Davis in various capacities as a full-time missions liaison/trainer, educator, Board of Examiners instructor, Senior Pastor, and Supervising Elder. Having simultaneously served in an ecumenical capacity under the leadership of Bishop Peter & Dr. Patricia Morgan as founding director of the School of the Arts at Caribbean Christ for the Nations & Kingston City Church (Montego Bay & Kingston), and Pastor Carrington Morgan (Board Member, City Life Ministries-Kingston), she and her ministry team return to Jamaica after 10 years to share in Arts-Evangelism, Community Activism & Engagement, Ministry to the Jamaican Girl Child, Building/Health/Wellness initiatives and more.

The Long Beach Unity organization will mark 20 years in 2020 of producing events, training youth, and transforming communities through its mission of bringing unity to diverse communities through music, the Arts, & healthy lifestyle initiatives. LBUF's Dancer in Me 2020 will feature 30 classes daily in dance, music, pageantry, drama, and spiritual formation, along with evening Worship in the Arts concerts and cultural exchange. We are excited to have the collaboration of the host District, the 16th Episcopal District led by Presiding Bishop Anne Henning-Byfield and Supervisor Ainsley Byfield, the Women's Missionary Society / Young People's Department (YPD), along with other AMEC Districts worldwide.
