ABOUT THE LBUF PROGRAM FUNDED IN PART BY THE MILLER FOUNDATION: SKY KIDS CREATIVE ARTS IN ACTION:

The LBUF Sky Kids Creative Arts in Action program is an afterschool arts enrichment program for children ages 6-12 facilitated in collaboration with the Long Beach Unified School District, Long Beach W.R.A.P., and COR Community Development Corporation. It is coordinated, implemented, and supervised by LBUF Executive Director Stephanie Adams, with strong support from the organization's President & CEO Steve Adams and the LBUF Advisory Board, LBUF College/HS Interns, and other professional artists.

The curriculum includes professional dance training (ballet, modern, lyrical, jazz, tap, & various cultural genres), physical fitness, martial arts, children's theater, music appreciation, creative writing, and visual arts. Each discipline is delivered by trained LBUF instructors focused on providing every child access to fun yet challenging content, exhibit a high-level of performance proficiency, and equip children for an ever-evolving artistic world while preparing them for academic arts advancement. Class sessions occur four days per week for 1.25 hours and are designed to teach children (and their families) the importance of unity in the Arts as a vehicle of transforming troubled communities.

Currently, Sky Kids Creative Arts in Action is in residence at 10 sites city-wide (8 LBUSD schools and 2 local communities). THE LONG BEACH UNITY SKY KIDS Program provides children strong alternatives and artistic options to help our students reach their full potential in the face of many societal, economic, and cultural barriers.

The future of the Long Beach Unity Festival is limitless. As the organization enters its 20th year anniversary of producing community events and serving children and their families throughout the city of Long Beach and beyond, we continue to sharpen and develop our skills and ability to creatively reach even more children with new methods, in new places!

LBUF NAMED AS INNOVATION 2 GRANT PARTNER:

• Long Beach Unity's Executive Director will facilitate and develop curriculum focusing on the healing power of creative Arts as one of several partners for the Innovation 2 grant in collaboration with its grantee, The Children's Clinic Serving Children & Their Families. Awarded by the LA County Department of Mental Health, the grant will be used to Develop Trauma Resilient Communities through Community Capacity Building. LBUF will create culturally competent, non-traditional self-help activities for families and their children with multiple generations experiencing trauma, including outreach engagement, intergenerational story-telling, intergenerational dance, and intergenerational mentorship programs.

LBUF INTERNS LAND CITY JOBS WHILE LBUF GAINS OFFICIAL CITY VENDOR STATUS:

- LBUF has successfully developed and cultivated a strong, working model of our Interns & Leaders Program. As a result of funds received from the Miller Foundation over the past two years, LBUF was able to successfully hire, train, integrate, and compensate three Cabrillo High School graduates (now attending CSULB and LBCC respectively) into the Sky Kids Creative Arts in Action programming at 10 sites across Long Beach in collaboration with LB Parks, Recreation, & Marine's WRAP Afterschool Program.
- As a result of the excellent performance of our Interns in working with the elementary school sites, 3 of our interns were offered interviews for part-time employment with the City. We are happy to report that 2 of our trained interns have now been offered jobs with LB Parks & Recreation, and will begin their employment in August 2019!
- Effective September 2019, LB Unity will serve as an official training and recruiting
 organization for recent High School graduates for consideration as part-time city
 employees with LB Parks, Recreation, and Marine. LBUF Interns become eligible after a
 minimum of 6 months training with LBUF staff.

Under the leadership of LBUF President/CEO Steve Adams, the Eagles Mentoring Program in residence at the 3,000-resident property of Avanath/Northpointe Housing in North Long Beach is thriving. After 3 years on-site, the LBUF staff has established an official basketball team for kids ages 10-11 years old. They entered the team into long-time Youth Basketball league, "The Wood", based in the Lakewood community, and the team

serve as a safe-place of mentoring for the kids, but also offer a variety of creative ways to assist in stemming violence, negative behaviors, and encouraging personal pride and self-worth in young boys of color. The success of the team has also generated active involvement of the kids' parents.

NEW PARTNERSHIP & SPONSORSHIP WITH THE WOMEN'S SHELTER OF LONG BEACH

LBUF President/CEO established a great partnership/exchange with Executive Director Mary Mitchell and Board Member Dr. Carol Grabowski of the WomenShelter of LB in the 2018-2019

season. Mothers and their young children from WSLB were able to attend free classes during the annual Dancer in Me Conference and they had a blast! Five families were represented. In exchange, WSLB donated brand new toys for over 100 of our Sky Kids attendees. LBUF will engage even more with the shelter families to offer encouragement & inspiration through the Arts for women and children.







LBUF CO-PRODUCES YOUTH CONCERT AT THE ORANGE COUNTY FAIR FEATURING SKY KIDS!

LBUF Executive Director co-produced the first ever Youth Gospel Concert at the Orange County Fair July 21st, 2019. In collaboration with COR CDC, New Hope Church, the event featured 35 Youth ages 7-17 in 3 original choreographic works, along with a youth choir, and youth orchestra. The Long Beach Unity Festival (LBUF) presented the 9th Annual Dancer in Me Sacred Arts & Music Training Institute (DIM) under

As part of the weekend-long activities, The Long Beach Unity Festival cohosted a kick-off fundraiser with LBUSD School Board member, Dr. Felton Williams to benefit the LBUF Sky Kids Creative Arts in Action program on Friday March 29th at Keesal, Young, & Logan, 400 Oceangate in Long Beach. The event fundraiser was sponsored

while providing creative & professional instruction, job opportunities, and spiritual enrichment. In 2019, LBUF experienced its largest number of registrants to date, with nearly 700 participants from across the nation, and internationally gathered to experience over 40 classes daily, 7 specialty tracks, and 30 professional instructors. Among attendees were nearly 200 LBUSD elementary students enrolled in the LBUF Sky Kids afterschool program.
